This Safety Alert is being distributed to the campus community because the suspect had contacts with law enforcement and may return to campus once released from custody.



Details:

On May 8, 2024, at approximately 2:15 pm, officers responded to a report of a subject causing a disturbance in the West Valley College Student Services Center. The subject, identified as Daniel Amare, was uncooperative with law enforcement and was given a verbal trespassing admonishment. Mr. Amare returned to campus on May 9, 2024, in violation of his trespassing admonishment. When Mr. Amare was contacted by law enforcement, he refused to sign a criminal citation and resisted law enforcement during his arrest. He was booked into the Santa Clara County Main Jail and was provided a written trespassing admonishment which is set to expire on June 3, 2024.

If you see this subject on campus, use caution, do not approach, and contact the campus police by dialing 911.

- REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY Criminals do not want to be seen or heard. We rely on the community to report suspicious activity. We would much rather respond and not be needed than to not be called when something could have been prevented or stopped. Trust your instincts; if something does not feel right, it probably isn't.
- BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS Avoid going to secluded areas of the campus alone. If you are going into a dark or concealed area of the campus, find a trusted classmate or colleague to go to these areas with you.
