


**RESOLUTION NO. 23062001**  
**ELECTING TO ADOPT LESS THAN HALFTIME BENEFITS UNDER SECTION 22807**  
**OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES’ MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL CARE ACT**  
**WITH RESPECT TO A RECOGNIZED EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION**  
**008 FEDERATION OF TEACHERS**

- WHEREAS, (1) West Valley-Mission Community College District is a contracting agency under Government Code Section 22920 and subject to the Public Employees’ Medical and Hospital Care Act (the “Act”) for participation by members of Federation of Teachers; and
- WHEREAS, (2) Government Code Section 22807 permits a contracting agency subject to the Act to provide benefits to its less than half-time employees, upon proper application; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, (a) West Valley-Mission Community College District desires to obtain for its employees the benefit of Section 22807 and accepts the liabilities and obligations of a contracting agency under the Section; and be it further
- RESOLVED, (b) West Valley-Mission Community College District elects to be subject to the provisions of Section 22807 of the Government Code; and be it further
- RESOLVED, (c) West Valley-Mission Community College District has fully complied with any and all applicable provisions of Government Code Section 7507 in electing the benefits set forth above; and be it further
- RESOLVED, (d) That the participation of the employees and annuitants of West Valley-Mission Community College District shall be subject to determination of its status as an “agency or instrumentality of the state or political subdivision of a State” that is eligible to participate in a governmental plan within the meaning of Section 414(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, upon publication of final Regulations pursuant to such Section. If it is determined that West Valley-Mission Community College District would not qualify as an agency or instrumentality of the state or political subdivision of a State under such final Regulations, the California Public Employees’ Retirement System may be obligated, and reserves the right to terminate the health coverage of all participants of the employer; and be it further
- RESOLVED, (e) That the executive body appoint and direct, and it does hereby appoint and direct, Eric Ramones, Associate Vice Chancellor Human Resources, to file with the Board a verified copy of this resolution, and to perform on behalf of West Valley-Mission Community College District all functions required of it under the Act; and be it further
- RESOLVED, (f) That coverage under the Act be effective on October 1, 2023.
