Details: On 02/15/2024 at approximately 3:30 pm, the suspect depicted below approached several students in the MC Plaza and accused those individuals of a prior theft. A verbal disturbance occurred between the involved parties and the suspect attempted to punch three individuals, striking two of them. The suspect also attempted to strike a passerby that attempted to intervene. The suspect then fled the area. Upon initial investigation, the suspect has been identified and the investigation is ongoing. As of the time this safety alert was sent, the suspect is outstanding and may pose a threat to the campus community.

If you see this individual on campus, do not approach her and immediately CALL 911.

UPDATE:

On 02/15/2024 at approximately 9:00 pm, the suspect was located and arrested. The suspect was issued a campus stay away order that expires on Thursday, February 29, 2024 at 9:45 PM. If you see the suspect on campus prior to the stay away order expiring, please call 911.
