Details:

On October 22, 2024, at approximately 9:47 pm, officers responded to West Valley College on a 911 call. The reporting party claimed he was being chased by unknown individuals on campus. When officers contacted the reporting party, he provided inconsistent statements and demonstrated suspicious behavior. Based on the circumstances, officers asked the suspect to leave and escorted him off campus. Later, officers received information that the subject was found by custodial staff, hiding in Science and Math building. Further investigation determined that a vehicle driven by this subject had been seen on campus at least five different days/times since October 14th. The subject is not a student or employee and to date has no legitimate reason to be on campus. If you see this person or vehicle on campus, please call 911, report your observations and tell dispatch about this safety flier.

Suspect: Hispanic male adult, 32 years old, 5-09 tall, 150 lbs., black hair, and brown eyes. Associated Vehicle: 2010/ White/ Toyota Prius/ California License Plate# 8MUG915.
